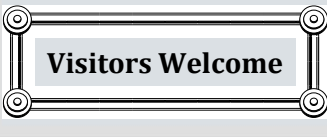

Solomon wrote from inspiration and experience the following words: *"He who loves silver will not be satisfied with silver, Nor he who loves abundance with increase. This also is vanity" (Eccl. 5:10).*

In the Sermon on the Mount, Jesus did not say that we *should* not serve two masters ... He said we *cannot* do so. It's impossible to make both God and worldly riches one's top priority in life. One must choose.
