HEAD-ON COLLISIONS

Stephen P. Beck tells of driving down a country road and coming to a very narrow bridge. In front of the bridge was a sign posted: "Yield." Seeing no oncoming cars he continued across the bridge and to his destination.

On his way back, he came to the same one-lane bridge, but now from the other direction. To his surprise, he saw another "Yield" sign posted.

He thought that was curious. He was sure there was one positioned on the other side.

When he reached the other side of the bridge, he looked back. Sure enough, yield signs had been placed at both ends of the bridge. Drivers from both directions were requested to give the other the right of way. It was a reasonable and gracious way of preventing a head-on collision.

When the Bible says, "Be kindly affectionate to one another with brotherly love, in honor giving preference to one another" (Romans 12:10), it is simply a reasonable and gracious command to let the other person have the right of way.

It is guaranteed to prevent a lot of "head-on collisions."
